

COMMUNITY PROGRAM:

Heartsaver® Pediatric First Aid, CPR & AED

Course Description

This course is designed to teach community members how to perform high-quality CPR, first aid and proper AED use specific to infants and children. This course will enable participants to recognize several life-threatening emergencies, give high-quality chest compressions, deliver appropriate ventilations and provide early use of an AED based on the American Heart Association (AHA) guidelines. This is a hands on learning program to maximize learning for participants.



Course Content

- High-quality CPR for children and infants
- First Aid Basics
 - Controlling bleeding & bandaging
 - Burns & electrical injuries
 - Allergic reactions
 - Heat or cold-related injuries
 - Poison emergencies
 - Fractures and sprains
- Use of an AED
- Relief of foreign-body airway obstruction (choking) for adults, children and infants
