### Community Contributions in 2022

- FHN's free community summer exercise competition, Miles and Minutes, promotes good health and gives money to area schools. In 2022, 330 participants logged a total of 251,018 minutes of exercise, and \$8,200 was donated to 7 area high schools
- Participated in the community-wide Connect the D.O.T.S. initiative to promote well-being — and being well — by helping individuals meet their basic physical, emotional, social, and spiritual needs
- Helped to serve families in northwest Illinois through 17 Rx Mobile Pantry Program events held in cooperation with the Northern Illinois Food Bank
- Administered more than 1,750 blood pressure screenings at no charge, including counseling and education

- Educated more than 1,100 people on poison prevention
- Offered health information through provider-led seminars to more than 520 people at 21 events
- Presented school programs focused on health to more than 1,600 students
- Donated \$16,575 to 11 area schools through sports physical clinics - a total of 14 clinics were held, serving 663 students
