



DRUG TAKE-BACK DAY

Unused prescription medications thrown in the trash can be retrieved and abused or illegally sold. Dumping or flushing unused medications down the drain or toilet can contaminate the groundwater supply. The best way to dispose of old medications is to bring them to a take-back event. The FHN Family Counseling Center, Freeport Police Department and Stateline Area Crime Stoppers are partnering with the State of Illinois and local and national law enforcement agencies to provide a safe, convenient, and responsible means of disposing of prescription drugs at a special Drug Take-Back Day in Freeport.

The public is invited to bring unused prescription drugs to the Freeport Police Department at 320 W. Exchange Street in Freeport for **safe drive-thru service**. (The site cannot accept liquids or needles/sharps, only pills or patches.) The service is free and anonymous, no questions asked.

Information on drug use and abuse and other health topics will be available at the event.
